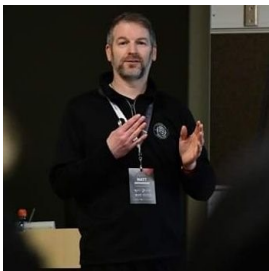

With approximately 15% of the Canadian population known to have a disability but only 0.09% actively involved in sport we have a great opportunity to make a positive change.
